Sealed Bids will be received by the Village of Mukwonago at 440 River Crest Court, Mukwonago, WI 53149 no later than 1:00 p.m. local time on March 30, 2016. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the above time and place.

Project involves relaying approximately 2,300 lineal feet of 12-inch water main, including, but not limited to, fittings, valves, hydrants and water services; rehabilitating existing sanitary manholes; temporary erosion and sediment control measures, traffic control, restoration and all appurtenances.

All Work is included in a single prime contract.

Upon ordering, printed Bidding Documents will be sent via customer's delivery mode of choice and the delivery charge will be dependent upon the shipping method chosen. Partial sets of Bidding Documents are not available. Neither Owner, Engineer nor Issuing Office is responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including any Addenda, obtained from other sources. The cost of Bidding Documents is non-refundable. Each entity obtaining Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office will be designated as a Plan Holder of Record. Bids received from entities who are not Plan Holders of Record may be returned as being nonresponsive.

A Bidder's qualification statement must be delivered to the Village of Mukwonago at least 5 days before the Bid opening date. Bids shall be accompanied by a Bond or Certified Check payable to the Village of Mukwonago equal to 5 percent of the Bid. If the successful Bidder fails to execute the Contract and furnish payment and performance bonds within 15 days after the award, the Check or Bid Bond may be forfeited to the Village of Mukwonago as liquidated damages.

Prevailing wage rates for all trades and occupations involved in the Work shall be in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes 66.0903 and the Prevailing Wage Rate Determination issued by Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development for this Project.

Bidder's attention is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract, Section 3, Segregated Facility, Section 109 and E.O. 11246.

Construction time is of the essence. Completion delays are subject to liquidated damages.

The Village of Mukwonago reserves the right to accept the most advantageous Bid, or to reject any and all Bids. Award of Work described herein is subject to the provisions of the Wisconsin Statutes.
