

Notice of Pending Application for Proposed Boat Ramp

The Village of Mukwonago P.O. Box 206, Mukwonago, WI 53149 has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to replace an existing public boat ramp on the bed of Lower Phantom Lake.

The project is located in the SE1/4 of the SW1/4 of Section 26, Township 5 North, Range 18 East, Village of Mukwonago, Waukesha County.

The project involves removing the existing boat ramp and loading pier and replacing with a new floating pier with a 12 foot wide concrete boat ramp on either side of the pier. The new launch will be located in the same footprint of the existing launch and will not disturb new area.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and a public informational hearing, if requested. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11 and 30.12(3m), Stats., and ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code, and ensure that the required mitigation meets the standards in s. 281.36(3r), Stats. if the project impacts wetlands.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will issue the permit for the proposed activity.

Any person may submit comments and/or request a public informational hearing by emailing Geri.Radermacher@wisconsin.gov or writing to Geri Radermacher, 141 NW Barstow St., Room 180, Waukesha, WI 53188 by U.S. mail. If you are submitting general comments on the proposal, they must be emailed or postmarked within 30 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. If you are requesting a public informational hearing, the request must be emailed or postmarked within 20 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. A request for hearing must include the docket number or applicant name and specify the issues that the party desires to be addressed at the informational hearing.

If no hearing is requested, the Department may issue its decision without a hearing. If a public informational hearing is held, comments must be postmarked no later than 10 days following the date on which the hearing is completed.

The final decision may be appealed as indicated in the decision document.
